SECOND SUNDAY OF LENT, YEAR B 2024: TRANSFIGURATION

Homily for the Second Sunday in Lent (Cycle B)

Genesis 22:1-2, 9-13 Psalm 116:10, 15-19 Romans 8:31-34 Mark 9:2-10

"SHALL I GIVE MY FIRST-BORN?" (MICAH 6:7)

"Take your son, Isaac, your only one, whom you love..." –Genesis 22:2

God the Father asked Abraham to sacrifice his only son, the one whom he loved (Gn 22:2). God the Father did Himself what He asked Abraham to do. For the Father, Jesus was His "Isaac," His only Son, His well-beloved (Mk 9:7). Nonetheless, the Father did sacrifice Jesus, "His Beloved" (Mt 17:5).

God spared Abraham and Isaac, yet He "did not spare His own Son but handed Him over for the sake of us all" (Rm 8:32). Scripture says that God "laid upon [Jesus] the guilt of us all" (Is 53:6). Just as Abraham had laid the wood upon Isaac's shoulders (Gn 22:6), God the Father allowed the wood of the cross and the sins of the world to be laid upon His Son's shoulders.

Therefore, realize to the depths of your soul that God is for you. "If God is for us, who can be against us?" (Rm 8:31) God the Father so loves you that He sent His only Son, that by believing in Jesus, you might have eternal life with Him in heaven (Jn 3:16). What God asks of you is to surrender your all to Him (Lk 10:27). Yet God first gave His all to you, His very heart, His Son Whom He loved (Mk 9:7).

Therefore, love the Lord with all your heart, soul, strength, and mind (Lk 10:27). Give your life generously to Him Who has given so generously to you.

Prayer: Father, You have never held anything back from me. Show me what I am holding back from You. I beg for the grace to give everything to You.

Promise: "My vows to the Lord I will pay in the presence of all His people." –Ps 116:18

Praise: Praise and honor to You, Lord Jesus! You take us to the desert to speak to our hearts (Hos 2:16). We offer You our lives as a sacrifice of praise (Ps 50:23).

Why Can't There Be Other Prophets After Jesus?

Question: I have a Muslim friend who says that he loves Jesus too and believes that he is a prophet, but that doesn't mean there can't be other prophets after him. What should I say to him? **Answer:** The Bible says that Jesus represents the fullness of God's divine revelation and so there will be no more prophets giving public revelation after him. There may be seers or people God has given private revelation, like what happened at Fatima, but there will be no more public revelation or a prophet like Moses. In fact, in Deuteronomy 18:15, Moses says, "The Lord your God will raise up for you a prophet like me from among you, from your brethren—him you shall heed."

This prophet would be the Messiah.

In Acts 3:18, St. Peter quotes this verse and applies it to Jesus. He says, "What God foretold by the mouth of all the prophets, that his Christ should suffer, he thus fulfilled." The opening verses of the letter to the Hebrews also say, "In many and various ways God spoke of old to our fathers by the prophets; but in these last days he has spoken to us by a Son, whom he appointed the heir of all things, through whom also he created the world."

Jesus also distinguishes himself from just another prophet in the parable of the wicked tenants, where he describes wicked tenant farmers, or the leaders of Israel, killing hired servants who represent prophets before they finally kill the son of the owner of the vineyard, or Jesus, who is not just another prophet. This all means that the time of public prophets is at an end because God sent something greater than a prophet. He has sent his only begotten son, the person who fully possesses the divine nature just like the Father, Jesus Christ. - Trent Horn(catholic.com)
