**PENTECOST SUNDAY (Cycle B)**

Acts 2:1-11 Psalms 104:1, 24, 29-31, 34 Galatians 5:16-25 John 20:19-23

**SUBMARINE**

"It was in one Spirit that all of us, whether Jew or Greek, slave or free, were baptized." –1 Corinthians 12:13

On Pentecost, after praying for nine days, we "receive the Holy Spirit" (Jn 20:22). In fact, we are "filled with the Holy Spirit" (Acts 2:4). Better than that, we are baptized in the Spirit (Acts 1:5), that is, we are immersed in the Spirit. We not only drink the waters of the Spirit but, in a spiritual sense, we are under and stay under these waters.

Living under the waters of the Spirit is a new life. Naturally, when we go under water, we can't breathe, but, supernaturally, being under the waters of the Spirit is the only way we can breathe fully. However, we are tempted to come up out of the waters of the Spirit for another whiff of the polluted air of the world and the flesh. "The flesh lusts against the Spirit and the Spirit against the flesh" (Gal 5:17). We must resist these temptations and stay immersed in the Holy Spirit. "When men have fled a polluted world by recognizing the Lord and Savior Jesus Christ, and then are caught up and overcome in pollution once more, their last condition is worse than their first" (2 Pt 2:20).

On this Pentecost, take the plunge and live under the baptismal waters of the Holy Spirit.

**Prayer:** Holy Spirit, fill me, surround me, and submerge me.

**Promise:** "No one can say: 'Jesus is Lord,' except in the Holy Spirit." –1 Cor 12:3

**Praise:** Praise You, Abba, for sending the Holy Spirit. Praise You, risen Jesus, for baptizing us in the Holy Spirit (Mk 1:8). Praise You, Holy Spirit, for filling the whole world and renewing the face of the earth! (Ps 104:30)

**Join the Diocese of Salt Lake City in participating in the National Eucharistic Pilgrimage!**

**MAY 31: ARRIVAL OF PILGRIMAGE AT ST. THOMAS AQUINAS :** The National Pilgrims on the St. Junipero Serra Route will arrive at St. Thomas Aquinas Catholic Church at 3 PM. There will be opportunities for Adoration and dinner. Mass will be celebrated at 7 PM. All night Adoration will start at 9 PM.

**JUNE 2: CORPUS CHRISTI PROCESSION TO ST. MARY OF THE ASSUMPTION:** Starting at 11 AM, the pilgrims will enter Park City on the Rail Trail and head towards the historic Old Town Chapel (121 Park Avenue, Park City). Adoration will happen from 1 - 2 PM, followed by a massive 4-mile Eucharistic procession from the chapel to the main church (1505 White Pine Canyon Road, Park City). Bishop Oscar Solis will say Mass at 5:30 PM, immediately followed by a dinner and celebration at 7 PM. [Click here for more info.](#)

**JUNE 3: DOWNTOWN SALT LAKE CITY:** On June 3, there will be a procession from the Cathedral of the Madeleine to the St. Catherine of Siena Newman Center. Mass and dinner will follow. Times TBD.

**JUNE 4: UINTA BASIN EVENTS:** Next, the pilgrimage will continue down to the Fort Duchesne Reservation Community with a procession at 10 AM. Mass will follow at 11:30 AM. In the afternoon, stick around for events on the historic Ute Tribe and Hispanic communities. St. Helen's in Roosevelt will host lunch at 1 PM and a Rosary at 3:30 PM. At 5 PM, there will be an evening procession from USU Vernal to St. James Catholic Church.

**JUNE 5: LITURGIES IN VERNAL:** The final morning will start with Mass at St. James in Vernal at 8:30 AM followed by Adoration. Then, there will be a final breakfast before the pilgrims continue on to Colorado.
