HOLY TRINITY SUNDAY (Cycle B)

Deuteronomy 4:32-34, 39-40 Psalm 33:4-6, 9, 18-20, 22 Romans 8:14-17 Matthew 28:16-20

FATHER’S DAY

“Make disciples of all the nations. Baptize them in the name ‘of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit.’ ” –Matthew 28:19

We have been created to be baptized “in the name ‘of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit.’ ” The word “baptized” means “to be immersed in.” The meaning of life is to be immersed in, that is, preoccupied with and consumed by the Holy Trinity (see Heb 12:29).

We enter into Trinitarian love and life through Jesus, the only Way to the Father (Jn 14:6) and the One Who baptizes us in the Spirit (Mk 1:8). Then the Father reveals the Son (see Lk 10:21-22), and the Spirit witnesses for Jesus (Jn 15:26) and proclaims Jesus as Lord (1 Cor 12:3). We are then immersed within a crossfire of Trinitarian love.

To be drawn even more deeply into the mystery of Trinitarian love, one of the most important events which must occur is for the Spirit to cry out in our hearts “Abba,” that is, “Father” (Rm 8:15; Gal 4:6). When we know the Father’s love so personally, we are usually immersed in the Trinity forever. However, we may withdraw from Trinitarian love if we quench the Spirit by refusing to trust God the Father, forgive our earthly fathers, or repent of our sins of selfishness and self-reliance.

Are you going to remain with the Trinity or back out? The Holy Spirit is crying “Abba.” Fall into your Father’s arms.

Prayer: Abba...

Promise: “And know that I am with you always, until the end of the world!” –Mt 28:20

Praise: All praise and glory is yours, Father, Son, and Holy Spirit, now and forever.

Join the Diocese of Salt Lake City in participating in the National Eucharistic Pilgrimage!

MAY 31: ARRIVAL OF PILGRIMAGE AT ST. THOMAS AQUINAS : The National Pilgrims on the St. Junipero Serra Route will arrive at St. Thomas Aquinas Catholic Church at 3 PM. There will be opportunities for Adoration and dinner. Mass will be celebrated at 7 PM. All night Adoration will start at 9 PM.

JUNE 2: CORPUS CHRISTI PROCESSION TO ST. MARY OF THE ASSUMPTION: Starting at 11 AM, the pilgrims will enter Park City on the Rail Trail and head towards the historic Old Town Chapel (121 Park Avenue, Park City). Adoration will happen from 1 - 2 PM, followed by a massive 4-mile Eucharistic procession from the chapel to the main church (1505 White Pine Canyon Road, Park City). Bishop Oscar Solis will say Mass at 5:30 PM, immediately followed by a dinner and celebration at 7 PM. [Click here for more info.](#)

JUNE 3: DOWNTOWN SALT LAKE CITY: On June 3, there will be a procession from the Cathedral of the Madeleine to the St. Catherine of Siena Newman Center. Mass and dinner will follow. Times TBD.

JUNE 4: UINTA BASIN EVENTS: Next, the pilgrimage will continue down to the Fort Duchesne Reservation Community with a procession at 10 AM. Mass will follow at 11:30 AM. In the afternoon, stick around for events on the historic Ute Tribe and Hispanic communities. St. Helen's in Roosevelt will host lunch at 1 PM and a Rosary at 3:30 PM. At 5 PM, there will be an evening procession from USU Vernal to St. James Catholic Church.

JUNE 5: LITURGIES IN VERNAL: The final morning will start with Mass at St. James in Vernal at 8:30 AM followed by Adoration. Then, there will be a final breakfast before the pilgrims continue on to Colorado.
