Good Shepherd Sunday

While studying at the Seminary, I remember a classmate reading the books of father José Luis Martín Descalzo, which also motivated me to seek out and read his books. He soon became one of my favorite authors, but it wasn't until recently that I discovered a truly surprising fact about this great priest: the story of his vocation, told by another great catholic priest, Carlos González Valles, SJ, in his book "Gospel Now!"

"He was twelve years old when his father, who was a clerk at the León City Hall, went with his family to spend Christmas at the home of Don Cosme, parish priest of San Cebrián de Arriba and brother of José Luis's mother. It was night time and it had snowed. There was a knock at the door: "Is the priest there? Mrs. Juliana has become very ill in Roblavieja. The doctor told me to let you know that she might not make it through the night. I'm going down to San Esteban to get some medicine." Don Cosme prepared to leave, despite his sister's protests about the snow and the night. "I know this route well. I've been walking this way for thirty years. It's only a four-hour walk." José Luis's mother had a woman's intuition: "Cosme, why doesn't the boy go with you?" "Are you crazy?" "I'd feel better that way." And so the elderly parish priest and his twelve-year-old nephew set off on foot.

They could already see the lights of Roblavieja in the distance, but they had lost their way, and the snow was deep. Don Cosme lost his footing and fell. No matter how hard he tried, he couldn't get up. He convinced his nephew: "You can't do anything here beside me. Run to the village and ask for help. I'll stay here." They came, helped him up, saw blood in the snow, and carried him away wrapped in a blanket. The priest said: "Take me to the sick woman's house." "If you die, die doing good." The next day, the bells of two villages tolled: in one, for Mrs. Juliana; in the other, for Don Cosme. The boy was so deeply affected by his uncle's beautiful death that, in his own words, "From then on, I began to dream of it for myself." A few days later, he accompanied a delegation from the village to request a new parish priest from the Bishop of León. The Bishop pointed to a map on the wall and said, "All those black dots are villages without priests. What has happened in one can happen in all of them. Where are we going to find priests for all those villages?" As he spoke, the Bishop placed his hand on José Luis's head. His heart raced. He managed to say with difficulty, "I... I... want to fill my uncle's position." The Bishop said to him, "God bless you, my son."

For priests in crisis

Let us pray for priests going through moments of crisis in their vocation, that they may find the accompaniment they need and that communities may support them with understanding and prayer.

DDD,

Each year, the diocese allocates a quota to each parish based on each parish's income. You may have some questions regarding the DDD. I will try to answer them using the following example: Imagine the diocese as a very large family: 12 children, each with their own family. However, the twelve children, along with their parents, carry out a mission together, for which they need to contribute financially to a common fund. In this case, the parents assign a quota to each child based on their income. In this way, the family sustains itself and carries out its mission.

The Diocese of Salt Lake City is that family, the children are each parish and the Bishop is the head of the family. Now, Notre Dame de Lourdes parish was extremely financially blessed in 2025. For that reason the DDD quota for 2026 has also increased significantly, we have been assigned \$138,900.00.

This number may seem large at first but our parish was extremely blessed last year. From that amount, we as a community will be responsible only for \$38,900.00. Thank God and a generous donator who gave us \$10,000.00, for DDD, we only need to collect \$28,900.00, and the rest will be covered with part of the funds the parish received as donations last year.

How are we going to collect the \$28,900.00? I have asked Jennifer Warner and Savannah Riche to be in charge of collecting all donations for DDD in the parish. That is, you inform either of them how much you are going to donate to the DDD. You can give it to them in cash, by check, or simply let them know you will make your donation online, in which case you indicate the amount of your contribution.
