The legend goes that one day as Saint Augustine was walking by the beach, contemplating the mystery of the Holy Trinity, he saw a boy who had made a hole in the sand and with a seashell filled the hole with sea water. The child would run to the shore, fill the seashell with water and would run back to fill the hole. Seeing this, Saint Augustine stopped and asked the boy why he did this, to which the little boy responded that he wanted to empty all the ocean water in the hole he made. Hearing his reason, Saint Augustine told the boy that it was impossible, to which the boy answered if he thought this was impossible, it is more impossible trying to decipher the mystery of the Holy Trinity.

In his book, "Letting God Be God," Carlos G. Valles, a Jesuit a priest, wrote: "Tell me how you conceive God, what you call Him, how you pray to Him, how you imagine Him when you speak to Him, how you interpret His commandments and react when you break them; tell me what you expect from Him in this life and the next, what you know about Him and have read about Him... tell me all that and you will have told me the biography of your soul. The idea a person has of God is the summary of their own life." The Catechism of the Catholic Church writes that "Over the centuries, Israel's faith was able to manifest and deepen realization of the riches contained in the revelation of the divine name. God is unique; there are no other gods besides him. He transcends the world and history. He made heaven and earth: 'They will perish, but you endure; they will all wear out like a garment...but you are the same, and your years have no end.' In God 'there is no variation or shadow due to change.' God is 'HE WHO IS', from everlasting to everlasting, and as such remains ever faithful to himself and to his promises" (n. 212). "The mystery of the Most Holy Trinity is the central mystery of Christian faith and life. It is the mystery of God in himself. It is therefore the source of all the other mysteries of faith, the light that enlightens them. It is the most fundamental and essential teaching in the 'hierarchy of the truths of faith'. The whole history of salvation is identical with the story of the way and the means by which the one true God, Father, Son and Holy Spirit, reveals himself to men 'and reconciles and unites with himself those who turn away from sin'" (n.234).

In 1831, Alexis Tocqueville, came to the United States to study the secrets of the trade of this nation. He was surprised to discover that the Bible was the basic tool of moral principles in public education, and that biblical teachings were the foundation of the social structure. The main problem of humanity in relation to God, is not a lack of faith in His existence, but in accepting His will for our lives reflected in His commandments.

The Father's Gaze

"Our children need to know that we see them - just as God sees us."

In this article written by, Trevor Williams, he reflects on how, as a child playing baseball, he always wanted his father to be watching and to be proud of him. Whether he made a great play or simply played with friends, he often wondered, "Did Dad see that?"

As he grew older and became a father himself, he noticed the same desire in his own children. Whenever they accomplish something, they immediately look to see if their dad is watching. This helped him understand how important a father's attention and approval can be in a child's life.

Williams then draws a spiritual connection. He explains that people have a similar desire to be seen, known, and loved by God. Unlike human fathers, who may be absent, imperfect, or limited, God always watches over His children with complete love and understanding. The author concludes that God's gaze is not merely observation—it is a loving awareness that knows each person's hopes, joys, and struggles.

In showing our children our loving attention, we reflect our heavenly Father, who sees, knows and loves them perfectly.
